



WIN Scholarship Application



The National Organization of Professional Women in NRCS (WiN) has the mission to provide its members with training, opportunities, and mentoring to develop into their fullest professional potential. Following its mission, WiN is proud to present a scholarship program. Every year WiN dedicates a portion of its budget toward scholarships for its members. WiN scholarships are open to any member in good standing, for the purpose of aiding the professional growth and furthering member education.

Scholarships will be considered on a quarterly basis, with announcements made in the "Winning Perspectives" magazine, WiN's website, and WiN's Facebook page. Applicants will receive electronic notification of approval and must submit receipts of expenses incurred along with a brief explanatory narrative of how the expenses apply to the awarded activity. For reimbursement, expenses must be incurred after the scholarship is awarded. Awarded applicants will receive reimbursement not to exceed \$500.00 after WiN's receipt of applicable and allowable incurred expenses.

Proposals must be electronically submitted by March 15th, June 15th, September 15th, and December 15th.

Eligible Expenses (maximum \$500.00)

1. Books
2. Tuition
3. Training Registration fees
4. Course fees
5. Travel and Lodging related to training

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a member in good standing of WiN
- Training, workshops and education must be from an accredited organization
- Must submit a complete application package which includes: application form and resume
- Must not have received a scholarship from WiN within the last 24 months
- If awarded, must write one article for WiN magazine "Winning Perspectives" within 60 days of the completed training. Topic of article: What three things did you learned that would be of interest to WiN members.

The following items must be submitted to be a completed application:

1. Completed application with signature
2. Resume

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Proposals must be electronically submitted by March 15th, June 15th, September 15th, and December 15th.
